Dear Families,

It is so hard to fathom that the time has arrived to prepare for the 2019-2020 program year! We are thrilled to share this year's registration information with you. For your convenience, [registration is online](#). Jen Cole, our Aleph Preschool Administrative Coordinator, will be in touch via email in the coming weeks once you've registered to process your child's registration intake. If you have not received an intake email by January 11th, please reconnect with us.

Beginning Monday, December 10th, registrations will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis, subject to availability. Current Aleph Preschool families will have 72 hours to register prior to registration opened to the community on December 13th.

We are very excited about our growth and encourage you to register as soon as possible to ensure your child has a space for next year! Subsequent to your intake, should there be space available, your child will be officially registered for the school.

Please note: in order to staff rooms accordingly, we will be unable to process teacher/friend requests for classroom placement this year. Applications must be submitted electronically along with your \$150 registration fee. Applications received without a registration fee will be considered incomplete.

Some need-based tuition assistance may be available. Our tuition assistance process is both blind and confidential. Tuition assistance applications are due by **March 1, 2019**. To start the tuition assistance process please be sure to indicate such on your registration intake form.

Be advised, reductions made to your enrollment selections after April 1st will be assessed a \$150 change fee. Any changes made to registration from June 2019- May 2020 require a 30 day written notice to go into effect.

By registering you accept Aleph Preschool Policies including tuition, change down fees, and 30 day cancellation notification. Further, Aleph Preschool reserves the right to terminate a child's enrollment at the discretion of the School.

Class Descriptions

Rolling Toddler: 1:7 Ratio

The Rolling Toddler class serves children starting at 16 months. (enrollment is taken throughout the year if openings are available)

Young Toddler: 1:7 Ratio

The Young Toddler class serves children starting at 16 months by September 1, 2019.

Older Toddler: 1:7 Ratio

The Older Toddler class serves children starting at 24 months by September 1, 2019.

Class Options: two days (T/Th), three (M/W/F), or five days per week (M-F).

Preschool Classes: 1:8 Ratio

The Preschool class serves children 3 years of age by September 1, 2019.

Class Options: three day M/W/F or five days M-F.

Pre-Kindergarten Classes: 1:9 Ratio

These classes serve children 4 years of age by September 1, 2019.

Classes meet five days per week 9:05-12:45.

Pre-Kindergarten Classes with Enrichment: 1:9 Ratio

This program is for students enrolled in our Pre-K program. In addition to the morning program, this class meets until 3:30 pm on M-F afternoons. The focus is on pre-reading skills, math and science, Jewish studies, creative arts, and nature and wellness.

Extended Care Program

Drop Off Options: 7:30am or 8:30am. Breakfast is served from 7:30-8:15am

Enrichment:

Monday: Stretch and Grow

Tuesday: Science

Wednesday: Judaics

Thursday: Wellness

Friday: Soccer

Pick Up Options: 3:30pm or 5:30pm/4pm on a Friday
